ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission Eligibility for Undergraduate Programs

- Minimum GPA 2.50 both in SSC & HSC (or equivalent) is required. If anyone has 2.00 in one exam, s/he needs to have GPA 6.00 in total.
- No less than five subjects in O level & two subjects in A level with a minimum Grade B in 4 subjects and Grade C in 3 subjects are required.
- Minimum total GPA 6.50 in SSC & HSC (or equivalent) and at least GPA 3.00 (without 4th subject) both in SSC & HSC with a minimum GPA 3.00 in both biology & chemistry and a minimum GPA 2.00 in mathematics at the HSC exam are required for the Bachelor of Pharmacy program.

Admission Eligibility for Postgraduate Programs

- Minimum CGPA 2.00 in the bachelor's degree and a minimum GPA 2.50 both in SSC & HSC or equivalent exams are required.
- Minimum 2 years' verifiable job experience (after graduation) is required for the Executive MBA.
- MBBS or equivalent or BSc in Nursing or BSS (4 years) is required for the MPH program.

Admission of International Students

NUB welcomes international students and makes every effort to assist them in getting enrolled in its academic programs. Special waiver is given to the students from other countries of the world. The tuition fees and other charges are at a reasonable level. The cost of accommodation and meals will be approximately USD 200 per month. An overseas applicant must obtain a valid student visa to study at NUB. Responsibility for getting a visa from the concerned Bangladesh High Commission/Consulate lies on the applicant.
